

**An Act to explain the Act to separate the County of
Bruce from the County of Huron.**

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the true construction of the first section of the Act passed in the session held in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to separate the County of Huron from the County of Bruce*, in reference to the proclamation for fixing the site for the County Town in the said County of Bruce ; for removing such doubts, Her Majesty &c., declares and enacts as follows :

I. The Governor in Council has had and shall have power to fix the site of the County Town for the County of Bruce in the same manner as he might have done under the provisions of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign chapter seventy-eight, if the Provisional Municipal Council, for the Township of Bruce had been constituted under that Act ; and the proclamations mentioned in the said first recited Act shall be held and taken to include the proclamation referred to in the Act last mentioned for fixing the County Town.

II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
