An Act to amend the Act for the qualification of Justices of the Peace.

[Assented to 19th June, 1856.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in this Province, who are now required to possess a property qualification, suffer inconvenience in consequence of being obliged to renew the oath of qualification on the occasion of the issuing of a new Commission of the Peace for the Territorial Divisions of this Province for which such Justices may have qualified themselves to act: For remedy thereof, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

Notwithstanding 6 V. c. 3, new oath of qualification not to be required on new Commission if J. P., holds the same property.

1. For and notwithstanding any thing contained in the Act sixth Victoria, chapter three, and intituled: An Act for the qualification of Justices of the Peace, it shall not be necessary in the case of any Commission of the Peace to be issued after the passing of this Act, for any such Justice named therein who may have theretofore qualified himself as provided by the third section of the said Act, to take any oath of qualification before acting under such new Commission, unless such Justice shall, since he took such oath of qualification, have parted with the estate in right of which he may
