Squash: 4 American championship singles squash court

Fitness: There are separate exercise rooms for men and women and each exercise room is fully equipped with fitness apparatus. Fitness programs are designed by trained instructors and these programs are geared to the fitness needs of the individual.

Additional Facilities:

- Separate locker and changing rooms for men and women which include bathroom, shower, sauna and grooming areas. A whirlpool bath, with designated hours for each, is available to both men and women.
- A members' lounge with picture windows for viewing the squash courts. A pro-shop. Ample parking.
- Air-conditioning throughout.
- One outdoor tennis court.
- Construction of two international squash courts are planned for June 79.

Swimming Pool: There is an indoor swimming pool that can be used for recreational purposes or as part of a fitness program. During the summer months, a sundeck will be available to the members.

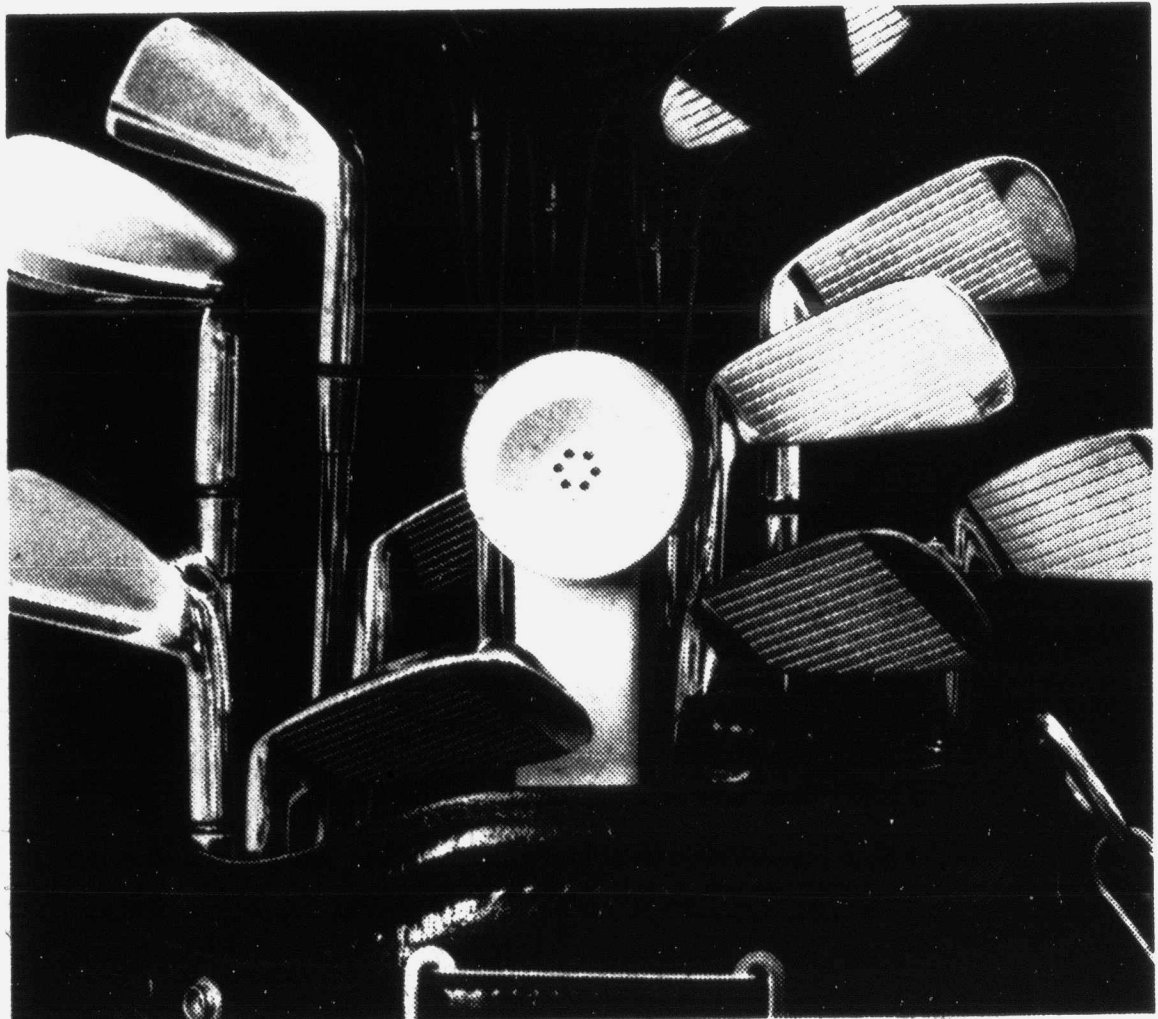
