Herewith is a set of regulations for confirmation by His Excellency in Council under sub-section (g) of section 98 of the Indian Act for the establishment of a pound and the appointment of a pound-keeper on the Dog Creek Indian Reserve, Manitoba.

Section 98 mentions a number of subjects with regard to which regulations may be adopted by bands, subject to confirmation by the Governor in Council, one of the subjects being the establishment of pounds and the appointment of pound-keepers on Indian reserves.

The Indian Agent has reported that there is some friction between the Indians of the Dog Creek Reserve and the adjoining white settlers. Under these regulations the Agent will be enabled to deal with cases of cattle trespass on the reserve.
