Air Commodore Charest officiated at the Service, following which the parade re-formed and marched past, Air Commodore Charest taking the salute. Protestant Church Parade fell in at 1030 hours, Wing Commander Johnston officiating at the Service, and taking the salute. Hebrew personnel also attended a special parade at 1030 hours. | |

Closing ceremony of B.C.A.T.P. and official closing of No. 2 S.F.T.S. held at 1400 hours, attended by His Excellency the Governor General and Her Royal Highness, Princess Alice; A/M Leckie, Chief of the Air Staff; His Excellency the Hon. Ray Atherton, United States Ambassador to Canada; Rt. Hon. Malcolm MacDonald, High Commissioner of the United Kingdom, Lt. Col. W.R. Hodgson, acting High Commissioner for the Commonwealth of Australia; Hon. David Wilson, High Commissioner for the Dominion of New Zealand; Dr. Frantisek Pavlasek, Czechoslovakian Minister to Canada, and Colonel the Hon. Colin Gibson, Minister of National Defence for Air. Aircrew wings were presented to all branches of aircrew graduates from schools across the Dominion, by His Excellency the Governor General.
