

GENERAL DISCUSSION

- 1 - Mortgages - Federal Government must make initial steps in the granting of credit and mortgage money to women with special need - provincial governments would then amend the law or adopt new legislation.
- 2 - Rights of Children - The granting of rights to women must be balanced with the rights of children.
- 3 - The speaker is a socialist. Unequal pay for women is a capitalist method of maintaining profits. Equality of job opportunity is very essential. In favour of abortion.
- 4 - Subsidized housing would aid younger women with low incomes.
- 5 - There are inequalities with regards to pensions for women who contribute as much as men. Wants research on the subject.
- 6 - Minimum Age for Marriage - Counselling services should be available to teen-agers to avoid forced marriages.
- 7 - Labour woman - Canada Pension Plan should be amended. Older people fired or displaced from jobs should be taken care of.
