I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 14th instant, in which you submitted an account of \$25.00 from the Hamilton City Hospital in the case of George Richards, and in reply I beg to say that this man is not a member of the Cape Croker Band, nor is he a member, so far as the Department is aware, of any Indian Band, and consequently payment of account which you have submitted will not be considered by the Department. The Hospital should look to Richards for payment for his maintenance and care while in the said Institution.
