Sir-

I beg to inform you that it has been represented to the Department that the Captain of the D.G.S. Quadra, of your Department, has erected a light on Birnie Island, situated to the North of the entrance of Port Simpson Harbour, which Island is a portion of an Indian Reserve. The Indians consider that permission should have been obtained from them as well as the sanction of this Department and that rental should be paid for the privilege.

The Indians ask that if their claim for rent is favourably considered, the matter might be adjusted by your Department paying \$25.00 per annum therefor.

I shall be pleased to hear from you in the matter.
