Re Canadian-United States Co-operation

In the year that has passed since the United States entered the war, the co-operation of the United States and Canada in the joint defence of the northern half of this hemisphere has been greatly extended. The armed forces of Canada are serving side by side with the forces of the United States in Alaska, as they had already been in Newfoundland. Canadian naval units joined with the United States navy in operations in the Aleutians. The chain of military airfields built by Canada between the United States and Alaska has been supplemented by the military highway built by the United States. Co-operative development of northern air routes to Europe and Asia has contributed greatly to the global strategy of supply of the United Nations.
