Conclusions

Already B. of C. has made its presence felt in life of the nation and is quickly acquiring the prestige, both in Canada and elswhere, which such an institution should enjoy:

New building, of which this stone will form so distinctive a part,
will assume a foremost place among the fine
odifices which are asking Ottawa a beautiful
Capital of which all Canadians may be proud,
just as the Bank itself is rapidly assuming
a place of first importance in the financial
and commercial life of the nation.
