The accused, A.28506 Gunner WEAVER, Alvin Franklin,
(R.C.A.), on strength of No. 1 Canadian Signals Rein-
forcement Unit, a soldier of the Canadian Army Overseas,

is charged with,

FIRST CHARGE
Section 18(2)
ARMY Act

WHILST ON ACTIVE SERVICE, WILFULLY INJURING
HIMSELF WITH INTENT TREACHERY TO RENDER HIMSELF
UNFIT FOR SERVICE,

in that he

in the Field, at approximately 0200 hours on the 27th
August 1943, when a sentry of the Main Guard, Delville
Barracks, No. 1 C.S.R.U., by discharging his rifle wil-
fully injured himself by shooting himself in the left
ankle and front part of the instep of the left foot,
with intent thereby to render himself unfit for service.

SECOND CHARGE
(alternative)
Section 40
ARMY Act

WHILST ON ACTIVE SERVICE, NEGLECT TO THE PREJUDICE
OF GOOD ORDER AND MILITARY DISCIPLINE,

in that he

in the Field, on the 27th day of August, 1943, did so
negligently handle a rifle as to cause it to be dis-
charged and thereby injured his left foot and rendered
himself temporarily unfit for service.
