In conclusion, I may say that while I agree with modern reformers in condemning the practice of exercise writing and the use of *à priori* methods, such as Ollendorf's, Ahn's Fasquelle's, Fasnacht's, etc., I cannot join with them in their condemnation of translations and the use of grammars, providing they do not drown the general principles in a sea of details.

Now, in conclusion, thanks to all who, by correction, suggestion, or otherwise, have helped in the composition of this synoptical grammar, and more especially to Dr. A. H. MacKay, Superintendent of Education, for having encouraged me to undertake this work, and to Principal R. MacLellan, of the Pictou Academy, for his kindly suggestions as to the arrangement of the work.
