ECLIPSES FOR THE YEAR 1814.

The first will be of the SUN, January 21st, at 9h 54m. in the Morning, invisible; the MOON'S lat. at the time of 1° 14' North. The SUN will be centrally eclipsed, on the Meridian, in lon. 33. 19, West from Greenwich, and 18. 37, south lat.

The second of the SUN, July 17th, at 2b. 7m in the Morning, invisible, MOON'S lat. 10m. North. The SUN will be centrally eclipsed on the Meridian, in 84, 11, East lon. and 30, 51, North lat.

The third, of the MOON, December 26th, in the evening visible, as follows:—

Moon rises, - - - - -	4 35
Beginning of the Eclipse - - -	5 57
Eclipse conjunction - - - - -	6 40
Middle - - - - -	6 43
End - - - - -	8 00

Digits Eclipsed 5 5-6 on the Moon's North Limb.

♀ Venus will be the Evening Star until the 12th of March, Morning Star to the 26th December, thence Evening Star until the end of the Year.

N. B. She will be invisible the whole of December.

♃ Jupiter will be the Evening Star until 2d September, thence Morning Star to the end of the Year.
