



## WEST DEMANDS FREE WHEAT

WESTERN FARMERS, AND WESTERN BUSI-NESS MEN GENERALLY, ARE PRACTICALLY UNANIMOUS IN DEMANDING THE OPENING OF THE UNITED STATES MARKET TO CANA-DIAN WHEAT AND FLOUR BY THE REMOVAL OF THE CANADIAN DUTY ON THOSE AR-TICLES. FOR THE PAST TWO WEEKS THE MINNEAPOLIS MARKET HAS BEEN FROM 5 TO 7 CENTS HIGHER THAN WINNIPEG, AND, WITH A MILLION BUSHELS A DAY BEING MARKETED AT WINNIPEG, WESTERN FARM-ERS ARE LOSING FROM \$50,000 TO \$70,000 EVERY TWENTY-FOUR HOURS, THROUGH BEING BARRED FROM THE SOUTHERN MARKET.
