Saving of the

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall not King's Rights and privileges of His Majesty, and of others. extend to weaken, diminish or extinguish the rights and privileges of His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, nor of any other person or persons, body politic or corporate, excepting only such rights as are hereby expressly altered or extinguished.
