Ordred, That Mr. Ramsay, Mr. Bagnall, and Mr. Goff do compose the said Committee.

Resolved, That a Select Committee be appointed, to whom shall be referred all Petitions relating to Paupers, to examine the same and report thereon to the House.

Ordered, That Mr. Hutchinson, Mr. M'Laren, and Mr. Anderson do compose the said Committee.

Resolved, That a Special Committee be appointed, to whom shall be referred all Petitions relating to Miscellaneous subjects, to examine the same, and report thereon to the House.

Ordered, That Mr. Swabey, Mr. Hutchinson, and Mr. Simpson do compose the said Committee.

The following Petitions were presented to the House, and the same were severally received and read, viz:

By Mr. Anderson—A Petition of divers Inhabitants of Prince County, praying this House to concur in any grant of the Assembly for the relief of the aboriginal inhabitants of this Island.

By Mr. Swabey—A Petition of divers Inhabitants of Grenville Settlement, Lot 21, praying for the establishment of a Post Office in the said Settlement.
