#63 HEREAS the Liberty given to the People coming from the Preamble. W & Country, to fell several Articles brought by them immediately by Hand, as is provided for by an Act intitled, An Act in Amendment of an Act, made in the Thirty Third Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intitled "An Act for the Establish-" ing a Public Market at the Market House in Halifax, and for re-" gulating the same," has been found beneficial both to such People, and to the Inhabitants of this Town; And whereas it is apprehended that if the Country People had further Liberty given them, to fell such their Provisions by Hand, at any Time; as well within Market Hours as without, it would still be more beneficial; Be it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, That any Person coming from the Country with any Quantities of Dead Meat, Poultry and Pigs Persons coming alive or dead, Roots, Greens, and other Vegetables, shall have free Liberty to fell and dispose of the same by Hand, in any of the Streets or Lanes of the Town of Halifax, to any of the Inhabitants of said Town (not being Butchers or Hucksters) at any Time, whether within Market Hours or without, and that fuch Persons shall have free Liberty to carry the same to the Market House, to be fold and disposed of there, without being put to any Expence for Stallage; any Law, Usuage, or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
