YNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS

WEST LAND REGULATIONS

A NY PERSON who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitole. Seskathewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dowlinion Land agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within the miles of his homestead on a farm of a least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or by cis father, mother, son laughter, brother or sisper.

In certain districts a homesteader in yood standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price 53.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six manchs in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent), and cultivate 0 acres extra.
