Women Junk Buyers Go Free

Found Guilty of Receiving Stolen Goods, Suspended Sentence Awarded

Mrs. Annie Rose and Mrs. Fannie Sakolinsky, the two women who were found guilty on Monday last by Magistrate Bates of receiving certain quantities of brass from small boys, knowing them to have been stolen, were brought up for sentence at the police court yesterday, and were allowed to go on suspended sentence. Magistrate Bates, in addressing the two accused, stated that he had found

them guilty of not stealing themselves, but of committing a worse offence than stealing by affording a market for small boys. Had they been men instead of women with babies, he would not have hesitated to send them to jail, for they richly deserved it, he added. His Worship lectured them severely and concluded by saying that he hoped this affair would put a stop to this pilfering and that the boys would take this as a warning if they were ever tempted to steal in the future.

Two charges against H. Lobe for receiving certain of the brass articles were dismissed at court this morning, for there was not sufficient evidence in Magistrate Bates' opinion to convict the accused. Although there were certain suspicions against him, his Worship gave him the benefit of the doubt, but not without a warning as to his future actions in regard to buying such articles.
