The D. W. P. spoke of the growing temperance sentiment in the Dominion and this province generally and in Kent and Northumberland counties in particular, and felt sure that the day of complete prohibition was not far off. New divisions had been organized during the quarter at Doaktown, Whitneyville and New Jersey. The meeting recently held in Newcastle had given evidence of awakening temperance sentiment there.

The reports of the D. W. P. and D. S. were handed over to the committee on the state of the Order, who reported as follows:

"We have examined the District Scribes reports along with the various reports of the different divisions and we find that in most cases these reports have been carefully prepared and show that within the district progress is being made in the temperance work.

"We regret a number of Divisions have failed to report.

"We note that the membership in Kent Co. has not grown during the quarter, while in Northumberland county there has been a marked increase. This we feel has been largely due to the efforts put forth by the G. W. P. Rev. R. H. Stavert.

"We would recommend that the District Scribe's suggestion re the establishing of a District Division for each of the two counties be submitted to the various Divisions in the counties by the Scribe and that he be asked to have a report ready for next meeting.

"We recommend also that the banner be awarded to Douglas-town Division and that the Scribe communicate with Grandville re the matter.

The report was received and adopted.

It was decided to hold next meeting at Burnt Church, if agreeable to that Division.

A vote of thanks was tendered the D. W. P. for the work he had done in the district.

C., who was one of the Eastern delegates to the Roblin banquet at Winnipeg and who is enthusiastic over the reception accorded the Quebec contingent. Yesterday he received a letter signed by Messrs. Jos. Bernier, M. L. A., Aimé St. Germain, M. L. A., and Albert Préfontaine, M. L. A., the three French Canadian members of the Legislature of Manitoba, which says: "We ask you to take back to your province of Quebec the assurance that our situation in Manitoba has become very much improved, for at last we are relieved of the double tax which bore so heavily upon us."


