Diplomatic Immunities.

Ambassadors, etc., cannot be arrested unless they are actually engaged in plotting against the security of the state to which they are saccredited, but they cannot be tried and punished ty the offended state. The law of the United States prohibits the service of writs upon the resident ministers of foreign states. In Great Britain, not only are the persons of diplomatic ministers inviolable, but all writs and processes, whereby their goods and chattels may be distrained, seized or attached, are "utterly null and void."
