Big Appeal Cases Pending, Hoppen-Dunsmuir and Abby Palmer.

Mrs. Joan Olive Dunsmuir will appear from the judgment of the Hon. Justice Drake in the case of Mrs. W. Walter Hoppen vs. John Dunsmuir, in which defendant's mother appeared as intervener. The brief is being prepared, and will, when ready, be filed, and a record for sale in any appeal which has been taken in the British Columbia Court of Appeal.
