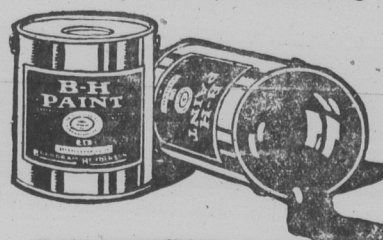

RESTIGOUCHE AND BONAVENTURE S. S. MEETING

Large Attendance of Delegates
From all Sections of District—
Interesting Discussions.

Campbellton, N. B., July 10th, 1919.
The Restigouche and Bonaventure Sunday School Convention met in St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Campbellton, on above date. President, Mr. Alexander Pratt in Chair. Convention opened on Thursday evening at eight o'clock with Devotional exercises, conducted by Rev. J. H. Barnes. Hymn, "What a Friend We Have in Jesus." Silent Prayer. Scripture Reading: "St. Mark Chap. 6:30." Keynote of this Conference to be "Drawing aside with Christ's Prayer by Mr. Barnes. Hymn "Nearer My God to Thee."
Address by the President, Mr. Pratt, paid a high tribute to the loyalty of the citizens of Campbellton, as demonstrated during the last year, which assures co-operation in every right movement and trusts that this Convention may prove a landmark one in the history of our Association. The address of Welcome was given by Mayor Murray, in which he drew attention to the different Conventions which were meeting at the different places, all for some purpose, a few with a selfish purpose, but that the Sunday School Convention was met for an unselfish purpose, mutual study for righteousness and rectitude, leading on to a grand and glorious hereafter; and his Worship, on behalf of the citizens of the Town extended a very hearty and cordial welcome to all visitors and delegates to Convention. Reply was given by Mr. D. Stewart. He said that the Mayor's words had left no doubts as to the welcome of the delegates, and trusted that each delegate would feel his or her great responsibility in this great work.
In the absence of the regular secretary, on motion by Mr. Reid, seconded by Mr. Stewart, and carried, Mrs. Stewart McLachlan was appointed secretary pro tem.

Address by Rev. J. H. Barnes, "Holding Our Corner." Here he spoke of the necessity of each one to the Sunday School holding his or her corner, from the pupil in the class to the Superintendent of the school. He innumerate the hindrances that come in the way of the child or teacher, being regular in his or her attendance and study, and of the deteriorating effect these in turn have on the other pupils and teachers. He laid stress on the necessity of asking for God's help. Hold your corner that others will be inspired to do better.
The General Secretary, Rev. W. A. Ross, having arrived unexpectedly, was called to the platform. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.
No report from Home Dept. or L.B.R.A. Supps.
Elementary Report given the time of Missionary Report at this meeting. Miss Dickie read report of Elementary Supp. showing one school reporting for Restigouche and ten for Bonaventure, of these four reported not in operation, two reported Cripple Bolla. Discussion of this report followed, and it was moved by Rev. Mr. Reid and carried, that this report be adopted.
The County Sec'y, Mr. Reid, read the Secretary's Report. Circulars sent to 46 schools, 23 sent to 100 officers and teachers; 1350 scholars, giving 1518 total members and 271 Cripple Bolla members, 245 Home Dept. making a total School Force of 1994. Four schools report organized lessons, 8 schools report Missionary instruction, 15 contributing to missions.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved. This was followed by an interesting report on Missionary work by Supt. Miss Keith in which she gave a few suggestions as to the carrying out of this work. 1st, have a Missionary Sunday; 2nd, Create a Missionary Clock; 3rd, Missionary Class; 4th, Telling Missionary Stories as illustrations; 5th, Pastor's Missionary Talk; 6th, Missionary Clock; 7th, Missionary Class Talk; and 8th, Missionary Prayer. Here he urged Patriotism and Loyalty as two means in Temperance Work. Discussion followed in which Rev. W. A. Ross favoured the signing of Pledge in S. School.

It was moved, seconded and adopted that this report be adopted. Secondary Division Report was given by Rev. J. H. Barnes ages from 14-20. 2 schools reported mixed classes, 5 schools report separate, and a number report no teen age class. He referred to the conspicuous absence of the boys and girls of 14 and over in our S. School. In Campbellton all the churches unite in the Boys' work and C.E.T., is taken up with good success. No work of the same character is taken up as far as teen age girls are concerned. Reports indicate 59 boys over 14 years, and 75 girls over 14. Help for this work can be obtained from Y.M.C.A.

After discussion, it was moved, seconded and carried that this report be adopted. In the absence of Mr. Kelly there was no report from Adult Supp. An interesting paper on teacher training was read by Mr. Carter in the absence of Supt. Rev. W. Camp. Here was urged the advisability of having a teacher's training class this fall. On motion this report was adopted.

Restigouche No. 2 Report of Nominating Committee was then presented by Mr. Reid: President—Thomas Young, Oak Bay Mills. Sec'y—J. T. Reid. Rev. Sec'y—Mrs. S. McLachlan. Children's Division Supt.—Mrs. J. C. Ferguson. Young Peoples' Supt.—Rev. J. H. Barnes.
