New School and Library Planned For Southeast, Paving Extension Asked

Site for Branch Library Is Sought in Neighborhood of Hamilton Road and Egerton Street

Plans are all completed for the opening of a new branch of the public library somewhere around Hamilton road and Rectory street, and the only thing that is lacking now is the finding of a suitable location.

"This is what we have been waiting for a long time," commented Ald. G. B. Drake, "and I know it will find favor with all residents around here. The average working man, when wanting to obtain some particular book has to go either to the up-town library or to the East London branch on Dundas street, and if a person has been working hard all day wants to go to the East London branch he has to come down here and transfer to an Ottawa car, and then, to get back to his home he has to take a car down to the city and transfer, and by the time he gets back he hasn't got much time to read an account of the time taken in his morning. If we have a suitable street car system it would be different, but, even if we had, there are enough citizens in this section to warrant the opening of another branch."

EAST END PAVING.

"All we need now to make this part of East London grow, and grow fast," he added, "is for the city to lay an asphalt or cement pavement from Egerton street to the end of the carline, and then they simply can't keep us down. By their work in laying the pavement down Rectory street and as far as they have gone on Hamilton road, they have done a great deal towards building up this section, and if they complete their work by paving Egerton street and the rest of Hamilton road to the city limits we will go ahead like a shot out of a gun."
