She was the wife of the late Robert Keithley, who died in 1899, and sister of William and James Morgan, of Warwick. Mr. and Mrs. Keithley were old pioneers of this section, Mr. Keithley having followed the occupation of blacksmith in the neighborhood of Arkona and Warwick Village some fifty years ago. Mrs. Keithley visited her many friends here four years ago, that being her first and only visit since they went to St. Louis in 1883.

There passed away on June 20th, in his 81st year, one of Warwick's old and respected residents, in the person of the late Mr. John S. Shields, whose death took place at his late residence, second line north, after a short illness. The deceased although not one of Warwick's earliest settlers, has resided in the township for upwards of 30 years. Born in Roxborough, Scotland, he, with his widowed mother and other members of the family came to Canada in 1854, settling in Mossa township, south of Arkona. In the year 1856 he married Mary Campbell, daughter of Duncan Campbell, of the same township, afterwards moving to the township of Dorchester, east of London, where he resided a short time, then coming to Warwick where he settled on his present homestead. He was a member of the West Adelaide Presbyterian Church and in politics a staunch Reformer. He leaves to mourn his loss the following members of his family: Mrs. Peter Craig, of the 8th line, Warwick; Mrs. D. D. Campbell, Mossa Township; his son James, and daughter Isabella, at home. His wife having died in 1889. He also leaves two sisters and two brothers, Mrs. Margaret Campbell, of Rokeby; Mrs. George Shortt, of Calgary, N. W. T.; Mr. Roland Shields, of Mossa Township; and Rev. Dr. Shields, of Melbourne, Australia. In the death of Mr. Shields Warwick loses a good citizen and a progressive farmer. He passed away with great peace of mind fully trusting in his Saviour for full and free salvation.
