STEADY.**

**RICHELIEU AND MONTREAL
STREET STRONG.**

TORONTO RAILS STEADY.

The Stock Exchange opened this morning with a rather strong tendency and dealing was brisk but limited. In the afternoon there was a falling off, Merchants Bank and Canadian Pacific fell off a little. "War Eagle" was again the feature of the day and sold up to \$2.01. The other stocks were steady, and as the quotations show, remain almost the same.

Canadian Pacific strong in the morning, but easing off $\frac{1}{8}$ per cent. in the afternoon, influenced by New York's weak closing. Richelieu sold strong in the morning at from 102 to 103, closing 103 bid. In the afternoon there were no sales but 103 was still bid.

Montreal Street Railway sold, in limited quantities, at an advance of 2 per cent., up to 257 at which price it closed.

Toronto Railway was another strong stock, and with trades aggregating 775 shares, sold up to 98 $\frac{1}{2}$, at which price it was offered at the close with 98 bid.

Dominion Coal Preferred, and Heat and Light, maintained their rises of yesterday.

War Eagle, on sales of about 6,500 shares at from 201 to 200 closes the same as yesterday.
