while Mr. Underwood is a graduate of Toronto University and is an associate member of the Canadian Society of Civil Engineers,

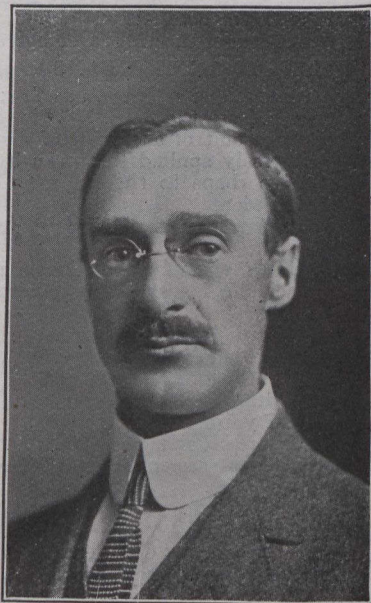
Their headquarters are in the new Ross Building on 3rd Avenue.
