the approval of the Assembly, may enter into such other arrangements as may facilitate the work of the Content into such other arrangements as may facilitate the work of the Organization.

Functions relating to other agreements.

CHAPTER XIV

INFORMATION AND REPORTS

File reports with Council.

CHAPTER XV

AIRPORTS AND OTHER AIR NAVIGATION FACILITIES

Designation of routes and airports.

Each contracting State may, subject to the provisions of the vention, designate the route to be full any international air service and the airports which any such service may use.

Improvement of air navigation facilities.
