

Trade with Canada:

We exported to Saudi Arabia an estimated \$630 million (Cdn) of goods and services in 1985. Our exports of goods chiefly comprise cars and trucks, barley, lumber and navigation instruments. The provision of services such as through Bell Canada International's multi-billion dollar management contract, makes an especially substantial contribution to the economic relationship (estimated at \$400 million per annum).

Canada's imports, mostly petroleum and related products, have been as high as several billion dollars per annum but have only been nominal in recent years (\$25 million in 1985).
