

ARTICLE IV


This Agreement shall remain in force for an indefinite period. However, either Contracting Party may, on or before June 30 of any calendar year after the year 1990, give notice of termination of the Agreement to the other Contracting Party. In such event, the Agreement shall cease to be effective for taxation years beginning on or after the first day of January in the calendar year following that in which the notice is given.

ARTICLE V


Both Parties agree to negotiate through diplomatic channels to solve any dispute arising from the interpretation or the application of the Agreement.

In Witness Whereof, the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments have signed this Agreement.

Done in duplicate at Caracas, this twenty-sixth day of June, nineteen hundred and ninety, in the English, French and Spanish languages, each being equally authentic.
