That the papers and evidence adduced by the members of the Special Joint Committee be referred to the Standing Senate Committee on Constitution whenever it is deemed necessary or when appropriate action is taken. (01) —
That the Standing Senate Committee be authorized to take evidence and representations from the provinces and territories, and to receive evidence and representations from the provinces and territories, when a member of the Senate or a member of the House of Commons is represented.

That the following Standing Committees, on behalf of the Senate or the Special Joint Committee, namely, the Standing Senate Committees on Constitution, Flynn, Flory, Hays, MacLennan, MacLellan, MacLean, Quatt, Yuzuk, and

That a Message be sent to the House of Commons to inform that House accordingly.
