moving back all items in the order of precedence any time an Order of the House causes the suspension of Private Members' Business. However, this would cause disruption to the planning for some 15 Members of Parliament, the debate on whose motion or Bill would be moved to another date.

Therefore, in order to keep changes in scheduling to a minimum and to interfere as little as possible in the notice as published in the *Order Paper*, the Chair is instructing that the item standing in the name of the Hon. Member for Skeena be dropped to the bottom of the order of precedence.

Private Members' Business

Again, this decision is without prejudice in the expectation that the House will pronounce itself upon this subject in the near future.

Therefore, there being no business before the House, I have no alternative but to adjourn the House until Monday next at eleven o'clock a.m. pursuant to Standing Order 3(1).

The House adjourned at 4.09 p.m.
