He must possess a sufficient knowledge of what he is required to do by law, as to entry and discharge, and the management of his crew, and as to penalties and entries to be made in the official log; and a knowledge of the measures for preventing and checking

the outbreak of scurvy on board ship.

He will be questioned as to his knowledge of invoices, charterparty, Lloyd's agent, and as to the nature of bottomry; and he must be acquainted with the leading lights of the channel or coast he has been accustomed to navigate or which he is going to use.
