Thus it is that the perfect man is the perfect and immortal idea of God. We agree with Mrs. Eddy that the perfect man is spiritual not material. We go further and say with Christ, "that which is born of the Spirit is *spirit*; not only spiritual *but spirit*, and therefore that which is born of Mind is mind. In this way the spiritual creation of man is seen to be brought about by God, Who is Love, Wisdom, Will and Understanding, forming the spiritual man from his proceeding Divine or Holy Spirit, which is good and truth. The will of man is formed from that good and the understanding is formed from that truth, and they become receptacles for the Wisdom and Love of God, which flow into them and yet are separate from them. Thus God dwells in man; Principle is in its idea; and man
