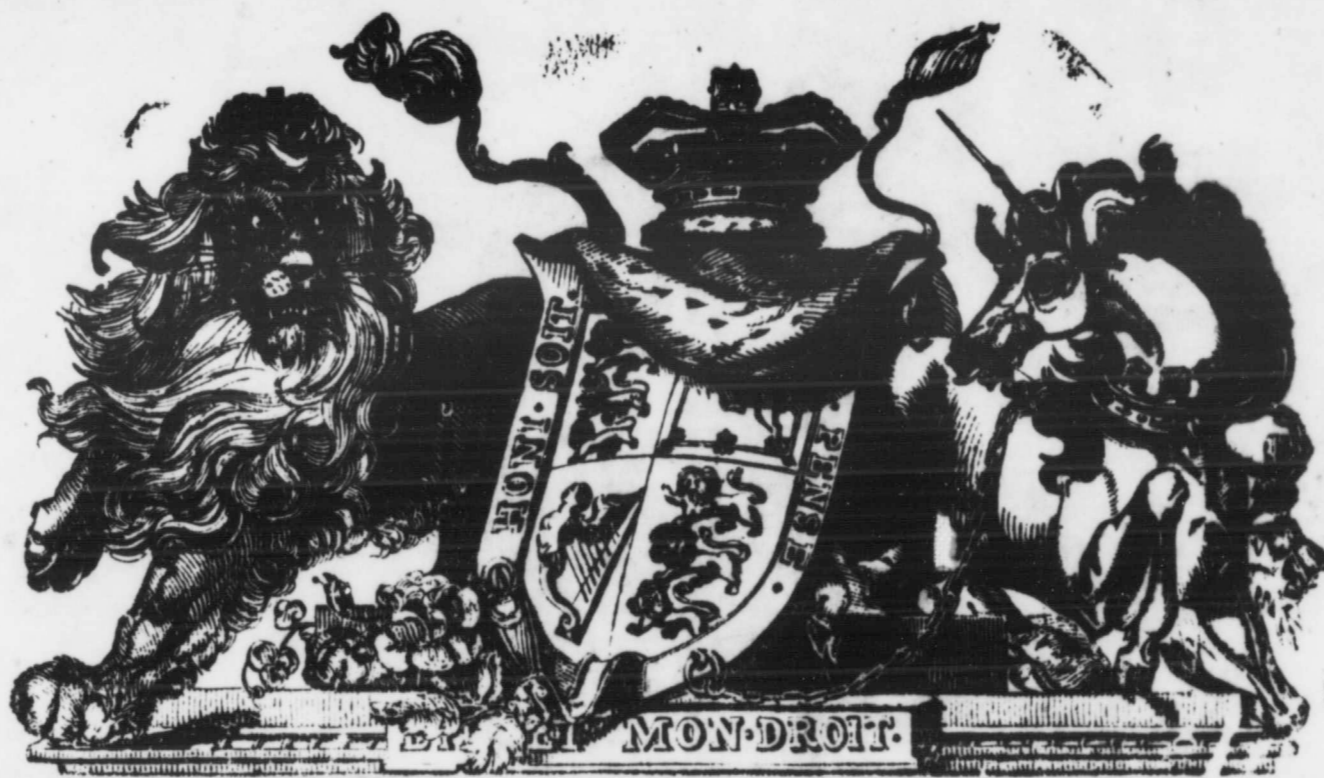


LUNATIC ASYLUM

For delivering on the grounds of the Asylum, before 31st October next, Two Millions of Brick, of the description required.
For constructing a solid Timber Railroad from the Wharf at the New Barracks to the site of the Asylum, according to specifications.

For Building the Rough Stone Foundation of the Asylum, according to specification.
And for constructing a Sewer from the Building to a ravine near the same.
