

13. Inspection: In May or June of each year, an Officer, detailed for this duty by the Minister of Militia, shall examine and inspect each Company and its arms and accoutrements, and shall report the result to the Adjutant General of Militia. On the report of the Minister of Militia to the Minister of Education for Ontario, that such inspection and examination have been satisfactory, the Minister of Education shall pay the sum of \$50 for the current year to the Board of Trustees concerned.

High School Cadet Instructor's Certificates: In order to afford High School Teachers an opportunity of qualifying themselves to act as instructors of Cadet companies, a special course of instruction will be provided in Toronto, lasting about one month. At the close of the Course, Teachers in attendance, and such other Teachers as may present themselves, will be examined by an Officer of the Department. Each successful candidate will be granted a special certificate to be called "High School Cadet Instructor's Certificate." The course of instruction for the Certificate shall be as prescribed.

Candidates at the Examination will be required not only to show themselves proficient in the different exercises prescribed, but also to be able to instruct a Company or Squad thereon.
