Any member may call for a division of the question when the sense will admit of it.

When a question is before the Association, no motion shall be received unless to close the previous question, to lay on the table, to postpone indefinitely, to postpone for a certain time, to refer, and to amend; the first three shall be decided without debate.

Robert's Rules of Order shall be the authority to decide all questions not herein provided.
