of the Dept. of Justice if the
question whether the Indians
of George Trotter should be
allowed to remain at their own
on the road situated on their
Reserve and to exclude the
public therefrom. Request Mr.
Baskerville therefore to furnish
as mentioned in letter of the
3rd Aug. last full and ac-
curate particulars of fact
as to when and under what
circumstances the road was
first made and particularly
as to the number of years for
which the road has been in use
by the parties and under what
if any, restrictions.
