Ask: I inform Mr. Baskin that
his letter of the 30 Jan'y last to which
he refers does not contain
sufficiently explicit and
accurate information to
admit of a proper consideration
by the Dept. of Justice of the
question whether the Indians
of June Lake should be
allowed to resume to their own
use the road situated on their
Reserve and to exclude the
public therefrom. Request Mr.
Baskin therefore to furnish
as instructed in letter of the
3rd Aug. last full and ac-
curate particulars of fact
as to when and under what
circumstances the road was
first made and particularly
as to the number of years for
which the road has been in use
by the public and under what
if any, restrictions.
