When a Ford sedan in which they were driving collided with the inward Maritime express 300 feet south of Bedford station, near Halifax, on Saturday evening, Captain James Adams of Hampton, commander of the Western Union cable ship Lord Kelvin, and James Terrell, K. C., of Halifax, were killed instantly. Captain Adam's body was hurled thirty yards from the scene of the accident, and Mr. Terrell's body was found in the demolished car. The two men had been to Commander Atwood's, at Bedford, for dinner, and were returning by the shore road. Captain Adams was a native of Scotland, but for some years had his home at Hampton, where his family lived while he was in the cable service. During the war he rendered valuable service overseas. On the face of it this seems reasonable, but there are very many individuals and still more important firms who could not answer for the political affiliations of all the members of their staffs.
