

Farmers Appeal In Vain For Exemption of Sons

Delegation of Five Thousand, Largest Capital Has Seen, Besieges Government; Premier Answers That Government Will do Its Duty

Ottawa, May 12—Five thousand farmers from Ontario, Quebec and New Brunswick, the largest deputation in the history of the capital, pleaded in vain with the government and parliament today for a relaxation of the rigid military service regulation, so as to exempt the food producers, or at least to grant them leave of absence till after the harvest. The reply of the prime minister was courteous but firm. The government, he declared, realized their difficulties but the stern task which the government had undertaken of keeping its pledge to the men at the front to provide the necessary reinforcements must be fulfilled. There could be no relaxation of the law. The only thing that was promised was that where there were special cases of hardship they should be brought to the attention of the minister of militia.

To the reiterated plea of the deputation's spokesmen that exemption had been promised them during the election campaign of last autumn and that, relying on these promises, they had gone ahead preparing for increased production this year, Sir Robert declared: "You speak of solemn covenants and pledges. Do you imagine for one moment we have not a solemn covenant and pledge to those men who have been in the trenches, some of them for three years. The promise of exemption was spoken in the national interest as we understood it last fall; the order in council passed recently abolishing exemption was also in the national interest as we understand it now."

While the answer of the prime minister, earnest and eloquent as it was, did not turn away the wrath of the farmers, it is significant that at this afternoon meeting in the arena, which partook somewhat of the nature of an indignity meeting the counsel of the speakers was that although disappointed in not securing the redress sought for nevertheless even if the government made mistakes their duty was still to do their utmost in the way of production, leaving the responsibility for the protracted decrease of production through the government's action to rest on the shoulders of the government. The deputation was passed favoring the circulation of petitions in every constituency calling for the resignation of all the members of parliament who failed to protest against the non-exemption of farmers, but the temper of the crowd finally seemed to be patient, even if somewhat resentful submission. Their final protests were lodged with the members of parliament themselves in the hope that the government might be finally induced to reconsider and at least make more effective provision for the "exceptional cases."
