



OCTOBER IN WALES

London, Jan. 10—The finding of the coroner's jury after an eight days in-quest over the victims of the Welsh col-liery disaster of October 14, exonerated the mine proprietors and all others from responsibility. The jury finds that the deaths were due to accidental causes, that the colliery was properly ventilated and inspected, and there had been no neglect. A few recommendations as to technical safe-guards were made.
