lead, (acetate of lead,) and dissolve them in six quarts of boiling water well mixed by stirring. When cold, the top portion of the mixture should be poured off for use, as the sediment consists of sulphate of lead, potash, &c. Any article of dress, no matter how slight the fabric, if well saturated with this liquid, and allowed to dry slowly, will bear the action of boiling water, and not permit it to pass through it.
