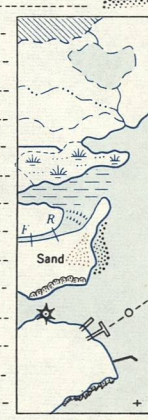

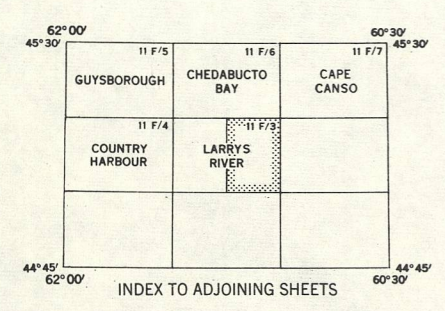

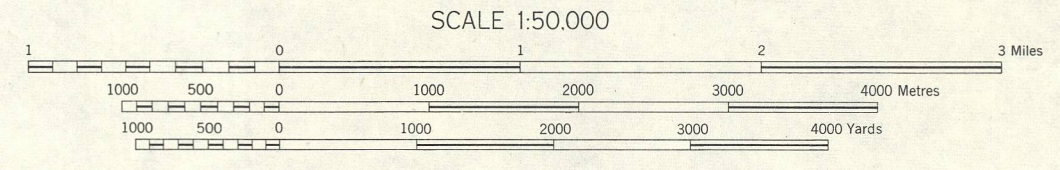


MAGNETIC DECLINATION 23°04' WEST,
