*Penitentiary Director, and Secretary to Board.*—JAMES GEORGE MOYLAN. B. 1826. Clk. in H. M. Customs, London, Eng., 1848 to 1851; Asst. Secy. to Chilian Embassy, Washington, 1852; Dominion Emigration Commissioner to Irel., from June, 1869 until Feb., 1872. Gazetted to present office, 10 Sept., 1872. Was employed on American press for several years. In 1858 established *Canadian Freeman* (Toronto), a weekly Catholic journal, of which he remained editor and proprietor until 1872. (*Salary* \$2,000) *The Grey Nunnery*; *Eastern Departmental Building.*

*Deputy of the Minister of Militia and Defence.*—GEORGE FUTVOYE, Q.C. B. 13 May, 1808. Was for time ed. of the *Morning Courier*, (Montreal). Held under Lord Durham the appt. of Inspector of Schools for the cities of Quebec and Montreal. Was afterwards apptd. the first City Clerk
