

B I L L.

An Act to amend the Law relative to the administration of Justice in Gaspé.

WHEREAS by Acts of this Session, Preamble.
 2 the present Courts of Queen's
 4 Bench (or King's Bench) and the Court
 6 of Appeals for Lower Canada, will be
 8 abolished after the time when those Acts
 10 shall come fully into effect, and a Court of
 12 Queen's Bench will be established having
 14 jurisdiction in appeal and error in civil
 16 cases, and original jurisdiction in Criminal
 18 matters, and a Superior Court will be
 20 established having original jurisdiction in
 civil matters, and the several Circuit Courts
 in Lower Canada will be united into one
 Court, the jurisdiction of the said three last
 mentioned Courts extending throughout all
 Lower Canada; and whereas it is necessary
 so to amend the Act hereinafter mentioned,
 that its provisions may be consistent with
 those of the Acts aforesaid: Be it there-
 fore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority
 22 of the same, That so much of the Act pas-
 24 sed in the seventh year of Her Majesty's
 26 Reign, and intituled, *An Act to establish
 the District of Gaspé, and to provide for
 the due administration of Justice therein,*
 as requires that the District Judges (who
 28 will be and be called Circuit Judges under
 the Act hereinafter secondly mentioned,)
 30 shall respectively reside at the place di-
 32 rected in the Letters Patent appointing
 34 them, or that any case in which a District
 or Circuit Judge shall be a party or shall
 be recused shall be heard or determined
 by or before any other District or Circuit
 36 Judge, or that any Writ be tested in the
 name of any Judge, or that any Bailiff shall
 38 be hereafter appointed by the Circuit Court
