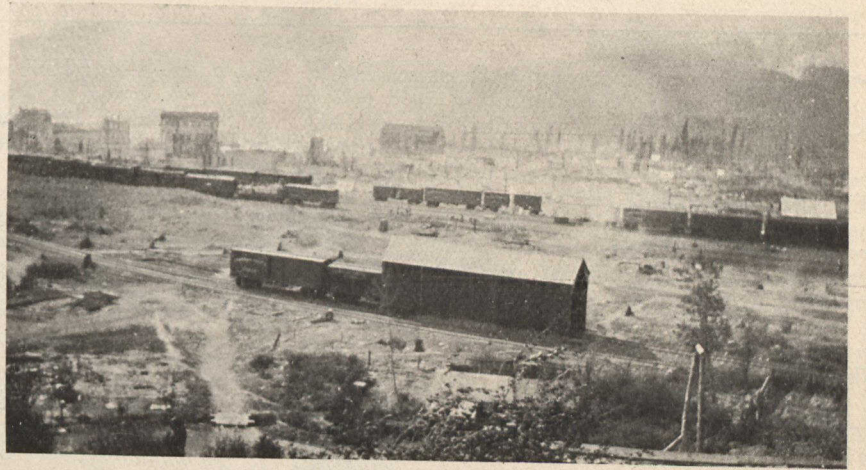
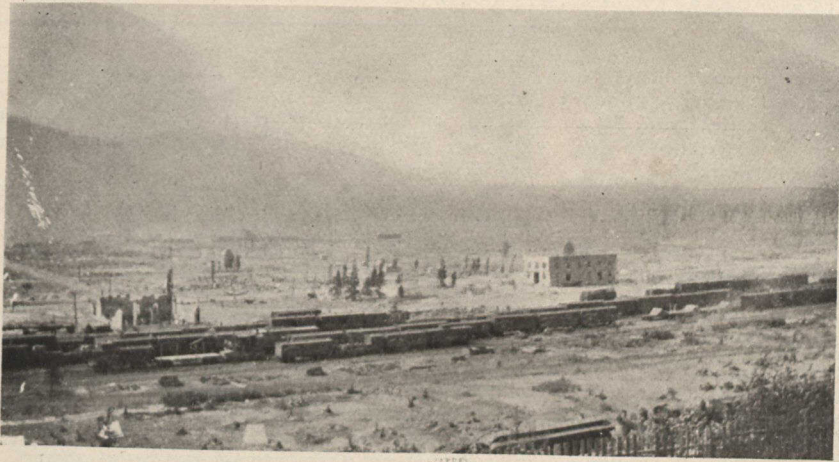
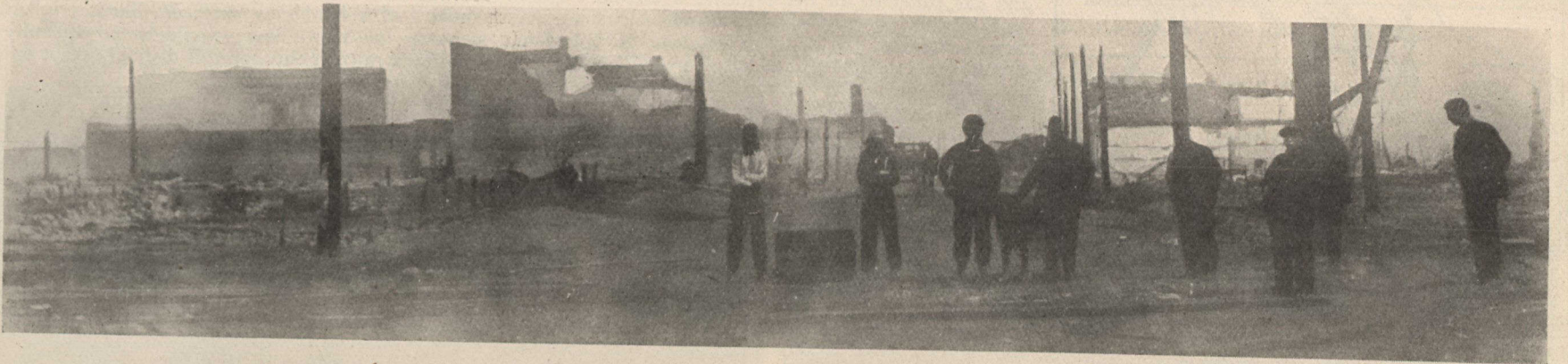


# BUSH FIRES CAUSE FERNIE'S SECOND GREAT FIRE



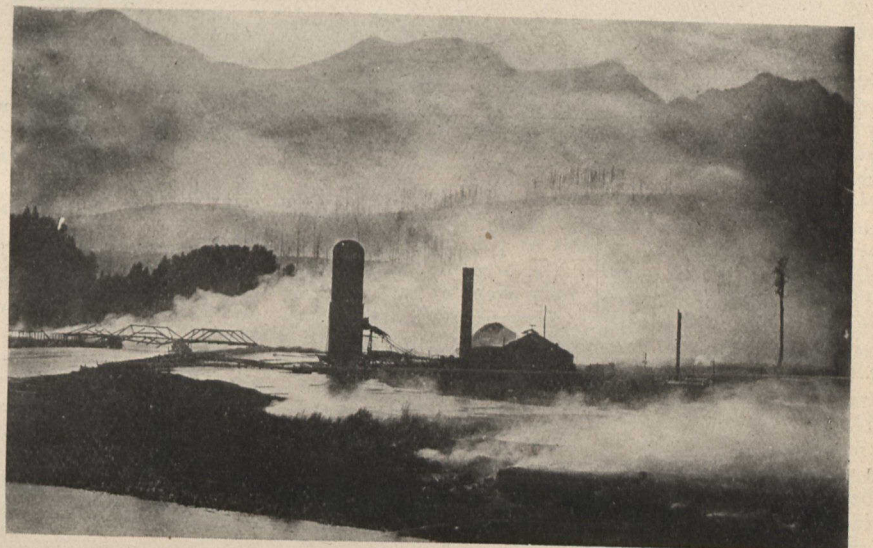
Two General Views of the Burned Town—One looking north-west and one north-east. The ten-year-old Mining Town of Fernie, B.C., laid desolate.
