Sir,-

The Department has been informed that through error wade in the construction of the road along the eastern boundary of Section 10, Range 23, W.P.M., the grade has been built partly on the Oak River Indian reserve No.58, and the Department has received a request for the transfer of the land so included to the Province. Kindly report if, in your opinion, the benefit to the reserve resulting from the construction of this road is sufficient to justify the transfer to the Province without compensation. If not be good enough to forward a report on valuation.
