

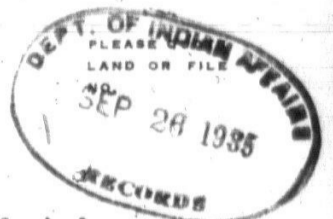

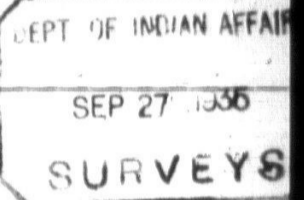

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 14th in the matter of the proposed exchange of lands in Big River Indian Reserve No. 118 for certain lands in 57-7-W3rd. I note that the proposed exchange set out in our letter of July 8th last was submitted to the Indians of the band and that the Agent reports that they are not willing to give a surrender at the present time for the exchange as proposed.

We were wondering whether or not the Indians had any proposition in connection with the exchange which they would care to have the department review, or as intimated in your letter, that they might reconsider the proposition set out in ours of July 8th at some later date.

We will be pleased to hear from you in this connection at your convenience.
