



Sir,-

I beg to inform you that voucher for the 18 bulls has been presented for payment through the Bank of Commerce, and it is observed that Duck Lake is charged with 6 bulls and Carlton 2, whereas only 3 were required for Duck Lake and 6 for Carlton, as per letter of the 6th instant and telegram of the 17th instant, addressed to you at Regina, requesting you to buy 6 bulls for Carlton.
